VIDEOTAPING REGULATIONS

There will be NO SPECTATOR VIDEOTAPING DURING SEMI-FINALS AND FINALS. Each club can designate ONE video camera to tape their own participants in semi-final and final events. A designated section for CLUB Cameras with camera credentials will be clearly marked in the spectator area. Club Camera Credentials are non-transferable. No videotaping will be allowed on deck. There will be no taping restrictions (except on deck) for figures. NO restrictions during team practice with music.


