VENUE RULES

- ❖ There will be a designated gelling area at the facility. Please gel only in this area. Those gelling outside of the area will incur a \$100 fine.
- ❖ Degelling will **not** be allowed at the facility. **\$100 fine** for degelling in the locker room.
- ♣ Balcony seating on the west side of the pool is for spectators. Seating for athletes is provided on the pool deck. For Finals, deck seating will be provided for those with Venue Passes. Ticket holders will be admitted to the balconies.
- Coolers, outside food (not purchased at the concession stand) and/or any type of food preparation devices are prohibited inside the facility.
- No glass is allowed in the facility.

SOUND SYSTEM

An OceanEars sound system with a variable speed cassette deck and variable speed CD player will be used.

FOOD SERVICES

A concession stand will be open at the pool for much of the competition.

OFFICIALS AND COACHES HOSPITALITY

Light breakfast, lunch, dinner and light snacks and beverages will be available in the hospitality room throughout the competition. Please allow officials to eat first.

DIRECTIONS

Airport to Flickinger Aquatic Center:

Go straight out of the airport exit onto the Kensington Expressway (RT.33) heading downtown. Stay on the Expressway to the end, about 8 miles, exit onto Oak Street (left Turn on Oak). Pool is 1 mile south at Oak St and S Division St.

PROGRAM

Team Photos: Participating clubs may send photos for the official program. Price is \$18 per photo for the May 13 deadline and \$25 for the latest deadline of May 20. Send payment with registration. Follow instructions listed below:

Photos sent by mail: Send color photos protected with cardboard. Type or print caption and tape to the back of each photo. Include complete name of club, description of photo (i.e.12-13 trio) and the swimmer name(s). Include an e-mail address contact for questions. Do not send money with photos but pay with registration form. Photos will not be returned.

Photos sent by e-mail: Photo must be scanned to create an image approximately 10" x 15" (1080 x 720 pixels) on the computer screen. Save digital file as a JPEG (.jpg). Set JPEG compression for high quality. If prepared correctly the digital JPEG attachment should be between 250 and 400 K. Photo will be printed in program approximately 3.5" x 2.75" (ONLY JPEG files will be accepted.)

Send photo as an attachment to an e-mail. In the body of the e-mail include the caption with complete name of club, description of photo (i.e. 14 over team), and names of swimmers. (DO NOT send a word text document.) Name your attached photo file a name that describes your team photo, (i.e. Swimkins 14 trio, digital file could be named IS14trio.jpg.) Send one photo and caption per e-mail (e.g 4 photos = 4 e- mail)
