*Team USA Set to Compete at X FINA Junior Synchronized Swimming
World Championships*

Indianapolis, Ind. – The 2006 U.S. Junior National Synchronized Swimming Team will make its debut at the X FINA Junior Synchronized Swimming World Championships, Oct. 7-11 in Foshan Guangdong, China. The meet will feature elite international competition in the solo, duet, team and combo events, and will be hosted by the China Swimming Association and the Guangdong Swimming Federation.

Meghan Kinney (Mission Viejo, Calif.) will represent the United States in the solo competition, while **Deborah Shim** (Concord, Calif.) and **Michelle Theriault** (North Hills, Calif.) will compete in the duet.
