(Any swimmer who is listed as an alternate for a routine and who is not swimming any other routine event shall pay the entry fee. (Rulebook, Appendix C, p. 3))
- Sponsor Fee \$20 per competitor. Make check payable to the <u>CCS Tailspinners</u>
- Credentials Each club will receive 2 coach and 1 chaperone credentials per 10 credentialed athletes. Chaperone credentials do not allow deck access. Tickets Spectator tickets for Saturday will be \$7. Children under five (5) years of age will be admitted free. Tickets can be ordered in advance (Form G).
 - The spectator area will be cleared at the conclusion of duet semi finals. All spectators (including those with credentials) may re-enter at 12:30. A ticket or credential will be needed to re-enter for finals.

Host Hotel to Pool: (Holiday Inn Belden Village) From Host hotel front entrance, turn right onto Dressler. Immediately get in left lane. Turn left at first light, Belden Village Avenue. The mall will be on your left. Go straight, past Damons. Continue straight and get on I-77 South towards Canton. Go to the next exit (Fulton Road). Exit at Fulton Road. Go straight (across Fulton Road) at the light. Take until you cannot go any further, McKinley High School will be on your left. Turn left and parking is located on your left. The Natatorium is the large building across from the High School and the Field House.

POOL SPECS Length: 25 yard Depth: 9 feet, sloping to 7 feet Width: 25 yards (8 lanes across) Indoor Pool

Entry: East End, spectators on right (additional seating on both ends) Practice space: Opposite end of pool and diving well

VENUE RULES

- Please obey lifeguards at all times. Food is not permitted on the pool deck or in locker room areas. Food areas will be marked.
- Glass of any kind or Balloons are not allowed anywhere in the facility or on the pool deck. Plastic water bottles will be allowed at the pool.
- There will be bleachers on deck for the athletes. Also, a gym attached to the pool area will be available for sport bags and equipment (no food or coolers allowed in this area). Spectators will be limited to the seating area above the competition pool. Seating capacity 2000.
- Please arrive gelled. There will be a small touch up gelling and de-gelling area available at the venue. Do not remove gel or de-gel inside the facility! Anyone observed gelling outside the designated gelling areas (touch up area) or removing gel in the facility will be fined \$100 to be paid immediately. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- In case of an accident, a lifeguard must be notified immediately and must complete a report. The Meet Manager should also be notified.
- The hospitality area is for officials, coaches, alumni and sponsors only.
- Locker rooms. Limited lockers available. NO LOCKS LEFT OVERNIGHT. They will be cut off nightly. Please designate on your entry information the names of any male competitors.



SOUND SYSTEM

An OceanEars sound system with a variable speed cassette deck and variable speed CD player will be used. OceanEars is the proud host of our officials/coaches reception on Weds. April 6th at the Holiday Inn Belden Village.

FOOD SERVICES

A concession stand will be open at the pool throughout the day for spectators and all attendees of the event.

ATHLETE FOOD: There will be a designated cooler area for **athletes** only. This is a very small area and there will limited tables/chairs in this area. This area is located outside of the gym and the west lockerooms. This is the only area where outside food is permitted and it is for the use of the **athletes** only. NO COOKING IS PERMITTED IN THE FACILITY.

OFFICIALS AND COACHES HOSPITALITY

Breakfast, lunch and snacks will be available in the hospitality room throughout the competition. Light dinner meals will be available on Friday and Saturday. Please allow officials to eat first.

OCEANEARS OFFICIALS/COACHES RECEPTION

A reception for officials, coaches, alumni and sponsors will be held on Wed., April 6th at the Holiday Inn Belden Village from 7-8 pm, followed by the Coaches/Officials meeting. OceanEars will be our host for the Officials/Coaches Reception.

VIDEOTAPING

Each club may designate one video camera to tape their own participants in preliminary/semi final events and team practice with music. <u>There will be no spectator or club videotaping of finals events</u>. No video cameras will be permitted in the venue during finals. Exception: Each club in finals will receive a video credential that can be used in the video designated area only to video tape their own participants in finals. A professional videographer will be recording finals events. 2 Videos will be available: Team/Solo and Duet/Trio. Videotapes are \$20 each or \$35 for both. This includes including shipping and may be ordered in advance (**Form C**) or on-site throughout the Championship. On Site Ordering Schedule will be in the registration information.



PRACTICE

Athletes may participate in the open pool practice on Wednesday, April 6th from 12 noon – 5 pm. The entire competition area along with the diving well and 8 lanes in the shallow area will be available. There is limited amount of additional pool time available and can be arranged through the meet manger if a team or individual is interested. A facility rental fee will be charged for all additional pool time. Additional pool time is \$75/hour and is extremely limited. Requests should be received no later than Feb. 14.
