Irvine, Calif. — The Speedo Junior National Championships kicked off competition at the William Woollett Junior Athletic Center today. The meet features athletes ages 15-18, competing for Junior National Titles in the solo, duet, trio and team events. The event is hosted by the Southern California Association and concludes March 31.

Today's agenda included semifinal competition in the trio, solo and team events. The top eight swimmers advance to finals, which take place Saturday, March 31. The duet semifinals also take place Saturday.

Top routines will advance to the 2007 U.S. National Championships which will take place April 26-28, in Indianapolis, Ind.
