World's Largest Synchro Meet Continues in Tonawanda 11-12 Age Group Champions Crowned

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. – The world's largest synchronized swimming competition got underway last weekend at the Town of Tonawanda Aquatic & Fitness Center. The 2010 eSynchro Age Group Championships run through July 3 and are hosted by the Tonawanda Aquettes and the Town of Tonawanda Youth, Parks and Recreation Department.

Monday's action featured the finals of the solo, duet, trio and team events for the 11-12 Age Group. Today's crowned champion in the solo was **Riverside's Catalina Nedelcu** who posted a score of 129.808. In the duet, **Santa Clara's Karen Li** and **Leilah Talukder** took the top spot (127.507) while teammates **Celine Joo, Jessica Kim** and **Stephanie Kim** won the gold medal in the trio (125.383). Santa Clara also reigned supreme in the team event (126.951).

The event continues tomorrow with the 13-15 finals beginning at 3:15 pm. Tickets for all finals can be purchased at the gate and will be \$10 for adults and \$5 for senior citizens and students. Below is a schedule for the remaining finals competitions:
