• **EVENTS** 1. In the Junior Open, US clubs may only enter three Solos, three Duets and three Trios.

Multiple entries in the Junior Team event are allowed.

2. Juniors and Seniors may compete in the Free Combination as a separate event.

Competitors who are 13 and 14 years of age may participate in the Free Combination event. A club or National Team may enter an unlimited number of Combination routines. An

individual competitor may be entered in only one Combination routine.

3. Foreign Federations may have multiple club entries, including their National Teams, in

each category: Junior, Senior and Free Combination (Open category).

4. The total number of competitors per Foreign club or National Team may not exceed 12.

- 5. In the Junior Open, each Foreign club or National Team may enter three Solos, three Duets, one Trio and/or one Team. Note that only one Solo or Duet from each Foreign club or National Team shall advance to Finals.
- 6. In the Senior Open, each Foreign club or National Team may enter two Solos, two Duets and/or one Team.
- 7. An individual competitor may only enter three events. They may in addition enter only one Free Combination event.
- 8. Junior athletes may not swim in the same event in both Junior and Senior categories of competition.
- 9. Senior entries must enter both technical and free competition. All Senior routines advance from Tech Prelims to Free Finals, with Tech Prelim results used for the draw.
- 10. Qualifying scores do not apply to Foreign Federations.
- 11. The top 12 in each event will move to Finals. The 13th place routine in each event will serve as the preswimmer for the event.

OFFICIALS

Please register online by the entry deadline. In addition, please email Judges Administrator Linda Loehndorf your intent to attend (loehndorf@charter.net). The dress for all events will be white tops and white bottoms.

FINA and UANA judges will be seated with U.S. judges on the event panels.

NOTE: Federations entering may submit up to two officials from the FINA and/or UANA List(s) of Synchronized Swimming Officials for the U.S. Junior Open and the U.S. Senior Open Championships. FINA and/or UANA Judges from Federations not entered in the competition may attend to practice judge.

COACHES

All US coaches on deck must be 100% certified by USA Synchro. Please check that you are certified on the USASynchro.org website under Education and the Coaching Certification Program. If there are any concerns, please contact Kevin in the National Office, and bring any proof of certifications not shown on the web site to registration.

SCORING

We expect to use three score scoring for free routines, and 2/4 scores for technical routines.

AWARDS

All competitors (US and Foreign) will compete for the same awards. Medals shall be awarded for places 1-3, and ribbons for places 4-12. In the Senior category, medals and ribbons shall be given to reserves (alternates) who swim either the Technical or Free

Routine. In the Junior category, medals and ribbons shall be given to competitors who swim in finals only.

PHOTOGRAPHER

Photographers will be present during the competition from Blue Cricket Productions & RavProductiopns. Photos will be made available for sale at the competition and online.

PHOTO/VIDEO REGULATIONS

Personal use photography will be allowed. No flash photography.

Any photographs, videotape or other audio and/or visual recordings of the event created by a spectator may be used solely for such spectator's personal non-commercial use, and may not be broadcast, published or disseminated, or used for any commercial purposes, without the prior written consent of U.S. Synchronized Swimming.

MEDIA SERVICES

To assist the USSS Media Relations Director at the event, please bring a phone/fax list of your local media outlets. You can acquire this list from a local university athletic department Sports Information Office, University Media Relations department, or your local government public relations office.

VENUE RULES

For Final events, tickets or credentials are required for admittance to the venue.

No-smoking allowed in the facility.

No glass containers on deck or in locker rooms.

Use of the pool equipment is not permitted.

All athletes will abide by the facility rules and USA Synchro Athlete Code of Conduct. Gelling and de-gelling in the designated areas only (\$100 Fine if outside of designated areas).

All equipment bags must remain in the designated areas to maintain a clean deck.

Official team banners will be hung by meet management (please turn in at registration)

Hand-made signs may not be posted.

Coolers are permitted on deck in designated area

NO electrical appliances are permitted.

A concession stand will be open during the Championship. Concession stand hours will be available at registration.

FOOD SERVICES

A concession stand will be open during competition times.

OFFICIALS HOSPITALITY

Hospitality will be provided for all officials, and coaches.

COACHES, OFFICIALS, SPONSORS & EVENT ORGANIZERS RECEPTION

A reception for coaches, officials, sponsors and event organizers will be held and is currently planned for Monday July 11. Details to follow.

PROGRAM

Participating teams are invited to send solo, duet, trio and team photos for the official championship program. Cost per photo is \$20. **Send digital photos only.**

Instructions: Photos approx. 9" x12" (size on computer screen) at 72 or 96 dpi make better quality printed images. Save photos as an uncompressed or high quality JPEG (.jpg) digital file. If prepared correctly the digital JPEG attachment should be between 400 and 700K. Send photos as an attachment to an e-mail (DO NOT send a word text document). In the e-mail subject line indicate the team name. In the body of the e-mail include the complete name of the team, club or college, city, state, names of swimmers/coaches—listed left to right / back to front. Name your attached photo file a name that describes your team photo (i.e HSC_Team.jpg) Send one photo and caption per e-mail (i.e. 4 photos = 4 e-mail messages.). Only images in the JPEG format and at the recommended picture size can be used for printing in the program.

Take the Interstate H1 E to Honolulu

Take exit 24B to merge onto University Ave

Turn right onto Dole St

Take the 1st right onto Lower Campus Rd

There will be a toll both to enter (\$5) drive straight to the pool entrance for drop off

Or take your first left into the parking structure.

Honolulu International Airport to OHANA East via H1 FREEWAY

From airport arrival terminal exit toward WAIKIKI/HONOLULU.

Go up the ramp and stay to RIGHT going east toward WAIKIKI/HONOLULU for 1 mile/1.61 km to H1 Freeway.

Merge onto H1 east.

Get into LEFT lane and continue on H1 east for .8 miles/1.29 km going toward HONOLULU.

Freeway will begin to veer to the LEFT.

Take exit 23 to PUNAHOU ST and get into RIGHT lane, turning RIGHT onto PUNAHOU ST.

NOTE: Kapiolani Women and Children's Hospital straight ahead.

Go south on PUNAHOU ST for one block (.07 miles/.11 km).

Turn RIGHT onto SOUTH BERATANIA ST and travel for one block (.06 miles/ .09 km).
