Tuesday, March 20, 2012 at 11:59 pm EST

Late Fees: Per Rule CP 5.6.1, any entry to a National championship received between 21 and 7 days prior to the first day of the competition shall pay late fees. Sponsor and Event Entry fees are triple the fees listed below, unless a technology failure can be proven to account for a late entry. If a qualifying event is held after the entry deadline for this competition, a provisional entry must be submitted according to the above deadline. Within 72 hours of the completion of the qualifying competition, the proof of qualification must be submitted by phone and in writing to the Meet Manager.

ELIGIBILITY

Each competitor may compete in no more than 3 different routine events in the Junior **NUMBER OF EVENTS** competition and 3 different routine events in the Senior competition. The Combination Event does not count as one of the 3 routine events.

All qualifying rules must be met for whatever event is being entered.

 Entry Fee \$25 per competitor per routine, including alternates. Submit fees online or via check

made payable to USA Synchro. Any swimmer who is listed as an alternate for a routine and who is not swimming any other routine event shall pay the entry fee. (Rulebook,

Appendix C). Foreign Federations do not need to pay the entry fee.

- Sponsor Fee \$25 per competitor. Submit fees online or via check made payable to **USA Synchro**.
- Credentials
 Each club will receive 2 coach credentials for every 10 credentialed athletes and 1 team personnel credential per 10 athletes. Additional credentials are \$25 each. Submit fees online or via check made payable to USA Synchro.
- Tickets may be purchased at the information/ front desk. Tickets for Wednesday and Thursday are \$5. Tickets for Friday and Saturday are \$10. An all-session pass may be purchased for \$25.
- Parking
 Parking will be complimentary in designated areas only.
- Canopies
 Canopies will be available for rent. The cost will be \$100 for the meet. The canopies will be assigned and set up by staff in the northeast grass area of the facility. Please contact Ron Wills to reserve your canopy.

COMBO EVENT

The Free Combination Event (Combo) may include swimmers from both Junior and Senior categories, as well as include 13-14 year old swimmers. There is no qualifying score for entering the Combo event. Teams that have both Junior and Senior swimmers should designate to scoring if they wish for Combo points to count toward Senior High Points or Junior High Points. The combination event shall be conducted as a 100% routine event. The top 8 combination routines from the preliminary competition shall qualify for the final competition. If there are fewer than 13 Combo entries, preliminaries may be waived and the competition conducted as **Finals** only.

COMBO AWARDS

Athletes who place 1-3 in the Combo final competition shall be awarded medals; places 4 – 8 shall be awarded ribbons.

Free Combo **DOES** count toward the High Point (individual and team) and All-American awards. If a Combo has both Junior and Senior competitors, **the team must designate the routine to count toward Senior or Junior team high points.**

Foreign Competitors shall receive honorary placements, and if finishing in the top 8, shall swim in Finals and receive honorary awards. Foreign competitors shall not be eligible to be pre-swimmer(s). No medals for alternates (reserves).

The first place winner in the Final Combo event shall be declared the Combo U.S. National Champion.

- **CP 6.3.3 For the U.S. Junior Championship**, competitors will receive points from the Free Combination event toward the High Point team awards. To qualify for Team points, a Free Combination routine must have at least 1 competitor participating in other U.S. Junior Championship events.
- **CP 6.2.2** For the U.S. National Championship, competitors will receive points from the Free Combination event toward the High Point (individual or team) or All-American awards. To qualify for Team points, a Free Combination routine must have at least 1 competitor participating in other U.S. National Championship events. To qualify for Individual points, a competitor must participate in at least 1 other U.S. National Championship event.

SENIOR EVENTS

Preliminary Free, Technical and Final Free routine competition in Solo, Duet and Team. Preliminary Solos, Duets and Teams may participate in both the Technical and Preliminary Free routine competition or participate in Preliminary Free routine

SENIOR AWARDS

competition only. The 8 highest scoring entries (combined Technical and Preliminary Free routine scores) shall qualify for the Final Free routine competition.

Athletes who compete in the Preliminary Free routine competition shall be awarded ribbons to places 1-8 in each event and the first place winner shall be declared the Solo, Duet or Team Free Routine Champion. Athletes who compete in the Preliminary Free routine competition only will not receive points toward the High Point (individual or team) or All-American awards.

Athletes who place 1-3 in the combined Technical and Final Free routine shall be awarded medals in each event; places 4 – 8 shall be awarded ribbons in each event.

The first place winner in the combined Technical and Final Free routine competition shall be declared the Solo, Duet or Team U.S. National Champion.

Foreign Competitors shall receive honorary placements, and if finishing in the top 8, shall swim in Finals and receive honorary awards. Foreign competitors shall not be eligible to be pre-swimmer(s). No medals for alternates (reserves).

Preliminary and Final Free routine competition in Solo, Duet, Team. The 8 highest scoring entries (combined figures and Free routine scores) from the Preliminary solo, duet and team events shall qualify for the Final Free routine competition.

Duet: 73.000 Team: 72.000

JUNIOR AWARDS

Athletes who place 1 - 3 in FINALS for solo, duet and team routines shall be awarded medals in each event; places 4-8 shall be awarded ribbons in each event. Athletes who place 1 - 3 in FIGURES shall be awarded medals; places 4-8 shall be awarded ribbons.

Foreign Competitors shall receive honorary placements, and if finishing in the top 8, shall swim in Finals and receive honorary awards. Foreign competitors shall not be eligible to be pre-swimmer(s). No medals for alternates (reserves).

Leaving rental car lots, travel north on E. Sky Harbor Cir S. toward E. Buckeye Rd. Turn right on E. Buckeye Rd. In .8 mile make a left toward All Terminals. Stay straight to go onto E. Sky Harbor Blvd. Proceed past Terminals 3 and 4. Merge onto AZ Loop 202 toward Tempe/Mesa. Travel 7.2 miles and take the McKellips Rd. exit, Exit 12. Turn right onto McKellips Rd. Travel 2 miles, then turn right onto N. Horne. Kino Aquatic Center is on the right approximately 1.4 miles south of McKellips Rd.

From Hilton Phoenix East/ Mesa:

Start out going northeast on W. Holmes Ave. toward S. Westwood. W. Holmes becomes S. Westwood. Turn right onto W. Southern Ave. Travel 1.7 miles, then turn left onto S. VENUE RULES

- Look for posted signs for directions to registration area, official's and coaches hospitality room, scoring room, etc.
- Swimmers and spectators shall obey lifeguards at all times.
- No balloons, noisemakers, or other irritants are permitted in the facility.
- No cooking allowed in the venue.
- Glass containers of any kind are not allowed on the grounds of the facility.
- Teams will be permitted to bring coolers into the facility. Coolers shall be kept in the team areas on the north and east side of the pool and shall not be allowed in the general spectator area.
- Entry and exit from the bulkhead, and walking across the bulkhead is not permitted.
- There will be a designated gelling area at the pool. Please gel only in this area.

- De-gelling is not allowed anywhere on the facility grounds. If anyone is found to de-gelling on the grounds, a \$100 fine per person will be assessed.
- For those leaving the pool directly for the airport on Saturday, de-gelling buckets will be provided.
